


# LANDOWNER BRIEF

## **Vision**

The Floodplains Reimagined Program is evaluating how to improve floodplain function for multiple purposes through voluntary collaborative partnerships with private landowners, sovereign tribal entities, government, and non-government representatives. RD 108 is managing Phase I with State and Federal funding.



# What to Expect

- Summer 2022 winter 2023 meetings monthly or every other month
- Virtual and in-person meetings in the region
- Available technical data and materials to inform landowners in their consideration of program participation
- Solicitation of landowner activities to support program objectives
- Solicitation of landowner input to influence the development of technical assistance and any financial incentive programs
- Development of potential subregional project portfolios
- Availability of technical assistance funding for landowners to plan/advance project concepts

#### **Vision**


To improve floodplain connectivity for multiple purposes through voluntary collaborative partnerships with private landowners, sovereign tribal entities, government, and nongovernment representatives.


