### **Program Overview**

The Floodplains Reimagined Program is evaluating how to improve floodplain function for multiple purposes through voluntary collaborative partnerships with private landowners, sovereign tribal entities, government, and nongovernment representatives. RD 108 is managing Phase I with State and Federal funding.

- Available technical data and materials to inform landowners in their consideration of program participation
- Solicitation of landowner activities to support program objectives
- Solicitation of landowner input to influence the development of technical assistance and any financial incentive programs
- Development of potential subregional project portfolios
- Availability of technical assistance funding for landowners to plan/advance project concepts

- Water managers serving water to private landowners




#### Vision
